Who Could Be a Founders' Scholar?

Any new student entering 6th -8th grades for the 2011-2012 school year who is accepted for admission and demonstrates academic excellence and the potential to make a difference for the greater good. Students selected as Founders Scholars' will receive a grant of 75% tuition reduction (\$6,712.50 value).

Qualification Requirements

Student must have an A average (3.5 or higher GPA in the 2010-11 school year) and be entering grades 6th – 8th for the 2011-2012 school year.

- Score in the 93rd percentile on an accepted standardized test or standard score at or above 125 on standardized IQ test.
- Parents/student must submit a MDS admissions application and Founders Scholarship Application and all supporting documents by May 2, 2011.
- Student must attend a half-day school visit prior to April 29, 2011.

Finalists

Founders Scholarship Finalists will be selected based on their admissions application, school visit, and supporting documents. Selected finalists will interview with the Founders' Scholarship Committee and will be notified thereafter.
